This grant is ongoing for projects needing funds of \$100 to \$1500. Grant proposals are accepted at any time. At the end of the month, all grant proposals completed at that time will be reviewed and receive the determination and feedback on the proposal by the 15th of the following month. Please submit your grant proposal at least two months before the time of the project to allow the proper procedures and time to possibly fund the project.

How to Apply for the Rize All Grant

To apply, you must submit all the below Grant Requirements altogether in one PDF to Amanda@RizeAll.com and Dane@RizeAll.com by the end of the month. Rize All will then review the grant application and you will receive the determination and feedback on the proposal by the 15th of the next month.



Grant Requirements

Cover Letter

Provide a Cover Letter with a summary of your grant proposal including all aspects below.

Project Description

Utilize one to two pages to explain in as much detail about your project. Please include:

- preferred locations
- dates
- timeline of events leading up to the project and during the project
- persons being utilized
- persons being served

and any other information relevant to your project that we need.

Please include a mission and vision for your project, as well.

Statement of Need

In one to three pages please describe and show the need for this project in your community and how you or your organization are the ones to solve this need. Please include:

- statistics and information about your community
- information that supports the need for this project

and as much information as you can with evidence to support the need in your community and how this need can be accomplished through the mission and vision of Rize All and the grant.

Please also include any past information from a previous project if this is a repeat project.

Goals to Accomplish/Measurements of Success

Please describe what goals are to be accomplished by this project and what measurements of success will be used to determine the goals are met. This can be done through:

- surveys
- before and after assessments

and other forms that fit the project goals and outcomes.

Please include any forms or questions that may be utilized.

Please also include any past goals and measurements that may have been used previously if this is a repeat project.

Market and Marketing Report of Project

Include a market report of those this project will serve and are targeting to serve. Utilize information about the community that can be found or information you have obtained.

Also, if needed for the project, include a marketing report of what your team will do to make the targeted community members aware of the project. Please include:

- a timeline of all the steps that will need to occur leading up to the project
- all materials and personnel that will be utilized

and any other information needed to spread the word and make the project successful.

Project Budget

Please include an itemized budget for personnel, important materials, and anything specific to the project. Be as specific as you can and include any research or evidence necessary. Please include:

- 10% matching funds in the form of dollar amount, personnel time, assets, or other
- personnel broken down by role in the project
- materials by what they are, how much, and their purpose
- any assets or personnel already purchased or available for use to support the event

and anything else specific for your project.

We will accept funding for anything appropriate and necessary for the project and at reasonable average market value including marketing materials, project needs, supplies, personnel, and more.

Provide a resume or bio of any lead persons on the project to demonstrate the ability to lead this project into full success.
